DELQUEST is a three day, two night supervised program that includes workshops, special leadership exercises, motivational speakers, and community tours.

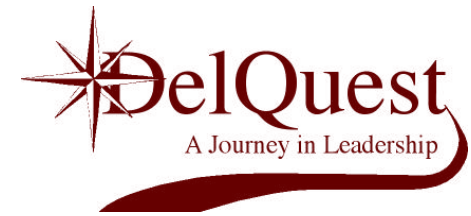
Chaperoned lodging will be provided Wednesday and Thursday evenings.

The application will be online complete and send when complete. You will need to print the reference letters and have your references complete. You may give to your Guidance Office or mail to the Chamber of Commerce before September 22, 2014.

Who can apply?

High school juniors from Del City High School, Christian Heritage Academy, Destiny Christian School; and local homeschoolers located in the Del City area.
